“Do better now, my child.”

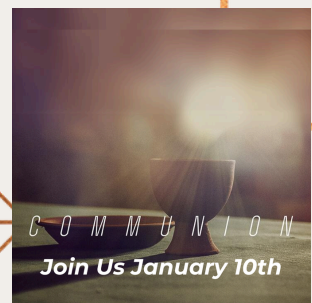
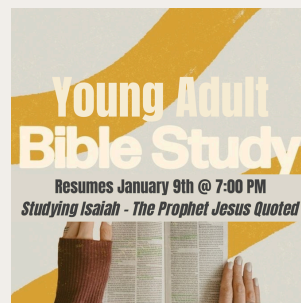
I went to the throne with a trembling heart;
